## WORLD MINUTE MOVIE CUP 1992

- 1. The length of the entry may not exceed 60 seconds (including titles and credits). Each country may submit only one film. Only countries which had a film in the first 16 finalists of last year's "World Minute Movie Cup" may present two films.
- 2. The entry may not be recognised as a commercial for any existing company or trade mark.
- 3. The producer must be in possession of all copyrights regarding music and pictures used in the entry.
- 4. The producer must accept SFV (Swedish Federation of Amateur Film) acting as his representative in negotiations regarding broadcasting of the entry. The producer also accepts that 60% of the sum connected with the entry will be forwarded to his national federation and that the remaining 40% will go to UNICA and SFV.
- 5. The entry must have been made on an amateur basis.

## VALUATION

- 1. The jury is comprised of five members.
- 2.16 finalists only will be chosen after the first round.
- 3. These 16 finalists will then be shown again and the winner subsequently chosen.
